Thanksgiving Helpers Want to control the craziness surrounding the biggest meal of the year?

- Create a game plan list everything you'll be serving and determine what others are bringing
- Need to borrow chairs? Air mattresses?
- Track down recipes

Maintenance

- Two shopping lists perishable and nonperishable. Tackle non-perishable ahead of time, but be sure to buy the turkey early enough to allow for safe thawing
- Do what you can ahead desserts, wash and chop vegetables, set table
- backwards, allowing time to roast the turkey plus one hour.

Kitchen Tips, Just in Time for Thanksgiving!

- Clean the space behind the fridge and vacuum coils. Clean interior surfaces with warm soapy water or a 50/50 mix of water and white vinegar.
- Wipe up oven spills with vinegar, soapy water or baking soda on a sponge.
- Oven racks or burner pans need some attention? Soak in dishwashing liquid and hot water. Keep kids away. If oven racks don't fit in the sink, line the tub with an old towel and soak as above. Ensure kids don't have access to that bathroom while there is water in the tub. Remove racks, drain water and use steel wool pads on the racks to take care of any remaining debris.
- Check your dishwasher for gunk in the drain or on the gaskets, wipe and remove. If an odor remains, place a bowl of white vinegar on the top rack and run the otherwise empty dishwasher through a full cycle.
- Splatters in the microwave? Fill a microwave safe container with water, microwave it until it boils, allow to cool a bit and wipe off the steam loosened gunk.
- Unplug toaster, pull out and wash crumb tray. Shake toaster upside down over sink to remove crumbs. Replace crumb tray when thoroughly dry.
