MAINTENANCE TIPS

Making sure your trash gate is latched after you remove your trash cans or put them back will go a long way to ensure your trash gate doesn't become damaged. During and after trash day, we notice many gates not latched, which causes them to get pushed in ways they shouldn't by the wind.

If your gate isn't latching properly, please place a work order online or with your RSS to have it adjusted so it latches properly. Also, storm doors are the same way. Make sure they are latched and not left unlatched to be blown around by the wind, which will help keep the door in good working condition
