TRASH SCHEDULE

Tuesday is trash day. Household trash, recycle and big bulk items.

COMMUNITY UPDATES

FIRE SAFETY PREVENTION

Simple tips to prevent fires and protect yourself, your family, and your neighbors.

NEVER LEAVE THE STOVETOP UNATTENDED

Use caution with oil and grease, as they can ignite easily. Keep flammable items away from burners and turn them off when done.

UNPLUG HEATERS WHEN NOT IN USE

Use your heater on a flat surface, at least one meter from flammables. Buy new heaters with a tip-over switch.

KEEP AN UP TO DATE FIRE EXTINGUISHER ACCESSIBLE

Tackle minor fires before they spread and remember it may need recharging if used.

AVOID SMOKING INDOORS; IT'S A MAJOR FIRE RISK

Never smoke in bed; properly extinguish materials and keep matches and lighters away from children.



FURNITURE, APPLIANCES, OUTLETS, AND CORDS

Keep flammable items away from furniture, check cords for damage, unplug unused appliances, and report issues. Clean the dryer's lint screen after use.

REPORT FIRE HAZARDS IN COMMON AREAS TO MANAGEMENT

Don't prop open stairway doors, as they contain fires. Keep hallways and stairwells clear for safe escape routes.

HAVE AN ESCAPE PLAN IN PLACE

Know your exit routes, set an outdoor meeting place, and conduct fire drills during the day and at night.

NEVER LEAVE BURNING CANDLES UNATTENDED

Blow out candles before leaving or going to sleep and keep them away from flammable items.
