MAINTENANCE TIPS

Keep your home cooler and help your AC run better with a few simple steps:

- Set your thermostat to 75 degrees or higher. An air conditioning system is designed to accommodate up to a 20-degree difference between the outside air and inside air.
- Keeping your fan on "Auto" ensures that air is conditioned before it is delivered.
- Replace your filters monthly or twice a month with pets in the home.
- Any blockage of a vent may cause failure of the HVAC system.
- Closing doors blocks the airflow into a space; this may create stale areas.
- Ensure all windows are shut and latched to prevent air flow around them.
- Close blinds or curtains during the day to keep your rooms cooler.
